

Seesaw learning platform

In Year 2 we are trialling the use of Seesaw in the classroom. Seesaw is a digital platform which allows us to record and share children's learning, especially that which is not completed in exercise books. It can also be used to assign work, engage with students, and provide feedback.

Parents are invited to connect to their child's journal and share in their learning. Seesaw is private. When you connect to your child's journal, you will only see your individual child's work, or group projects which your child is tagged in.
